



**Dual Degree Program Agreement**  
**Between**  
**Graduate Institute of Network Learning Technology**  
**NATIONAL CENTRAL UNIVERSITY, R.O.C**  
**And**  
**Electronics and Informatics Education Graduate School**  
**YOGYAKARTA STATE UNIVERSITY, INDONESIA**

**I. Objective**

Based on Memorandum of Understanding between two educational institutions, Graduate Institute of Network Learning Technology, National Central University (hereinafter referred to as “NCU”) and Electronics and Informatics Education Graduate School, YOGYAKARTA STATE UNIVERSITY, INDONESIA (hereinafter referred to as “YSU”) agree to develop the Dual Degree Program Agreement, aiming to cultivate international workforce, to provide students with an educational opportunity and to boost their competitiveness in the international workplace.

**II. Program Name**

This dual degree program is named as “NCU- YSU Dual Master Degree Program (hereinafter referred to as “Program”).

**III. Degree Conferral**

Upon successfully completing the Dual Degree Program, participating students who meet graduation requirements for this Program will be conferred an accredited Master degree from NCU, Taiwan and an accredited Master degree from YSU, Indonesia.

**IV. Eligibility, Selection Process and Quotas**

**A. Applicant’s qualifications:**

- a. GPA for undergraduate 3.2 on the basis of 4.
- b. TOEIC score at least 700 or paper TOEFL at least 525 (or equivalent).

**B. Application Procedure**

- a. Applicants should first contact the home department expressing their intention together with their applications, transcript, language proficiency certificate, study plan and interested field of study.
- b. The home department will pass the applications to the office of Double degree program or the office of the International Affairs of the home university.
- c. All the application materials should reach the Office of the International Affairs of the host university before May 15 for the Fall Semester and November 15 for the Spring

Semester.

C. Selection process:

- a. Phase I: The home department will select the qualified students based on their academic performance and relevant documents.
- b. Phase II: The partner university will assess the applications and notify the result before June 30 for the Fall Semester and December 31 for the Spring Semester.

D. Quota: maximum of 5 students each year.

**V. Length of Study**

Students should stay at least 2 semesters at each institution.

**VI. Articulated Curriculum and Terms of Degree Conferral**

- A. The students must take at least 8 credits of courses at host institution which are determined by each relative academic division and supervisor. The student is also required to complete a thesis to be granted a Master degree.
- B. The home institution determines whether the courses the participants take at the host institution will be granted.

**VII. Thesis Supervision**

Participants of the Dual Degree Program will conduct appropriate thesis research at both institutions. The supervision of project and thesis work will be resolved through the consultation between faculty members from both universities. The related details are described in the subsequent agreement on Joint Supervision of Master's Thesis.

**VIII. Credit Transfer and Acceptance**

Both institutions have the rights to determine whether the courses that the participants take at both institutions will be granted or not.

**IX. Matriculation, Registration for Courses, and Grading**

- a. The process of matriculation and registration for courses, and grading shall conform to the academic policies of both institutions.
- b. The host department is responsible for advising students in course registration. An official transcript from the host institution must be received by the home institution upon successful completion of the semester.

**X. Tuition and fees**

- a. Participants of this Program are responsible for paying tuition fees to their home institution. Tuition fees are waived at the host institution.
- b. Participants don't have to pay credit fees at host institutions.

c. Any other fees at the host institution are paid by participants of this Program.

**XI. Health and Injury Insurance Policy**

Participants of this Program are required to purchase health and injury insurance.

**XII. Effectiveness, Modification and Termination**

This Agreement shall take effect on the date of final signature. This Dual Master Degree Program Agreement may be terminated according to the same terms set forth in Memorandum of Understanding between NCU and YSU. If either institution intends to terminate or to modify this Agreement, a written notice should be given to the other institution six (6) months prior to the desired effective date of termination.

**XIII.** If terms and conditions of this Agreement are not mentioned, the parties to this Dual Master Degree Program Agreement hereby agree to consult under terms of MOU between both institutions.




